Numerous education institutions are based in Bydgoszcz: Casimir the Great University, University of Technology and Life Sciences, conservatory. Bydgoszcz Diocese, local stations of Polish Radio and Television, Airport as well as numerous organs of administrations are based in the city. The city takes pride in its cultural institutions: Ignacy Paderewski Concert Hall, Polish Theatre, Nova Opera, and the Łuczniczka arena.





Sensei Morio Higaonna was born on 25 December 1938. He took up Shorin-ryu karate at the age of fourteen. At that time, he complemented his training with exercises on makiwara. His stikes later became world famous. When he was sixteen, he began training in the Goju-ryu style, in the garden dojo of Chojun Miyagi. His instructor was sensei Anichi Miyagi. In 1957 the garden dojo moved to a new building named Jundokan, where he spent five hours a day training under the supervision of Eiichi Miyazato and Anichi Miyagi. He also trained kobudo, and his specialised in Sai.



In 1960 Higaonna moved to Tokyo to study at the University of Takushoku, and it was at that time when he started teaching karate in a famous dojo Yoyogi. His technique and incredible power amazed his students. He continued teaching there for twenty-one years gaining such great popularity that sometimes over 1000 people participated in his training daily. Starting from 1970, he strated travelling around the world teaching Okinawa Goju-ryu. Since 1979 he has been the IOGKF Chief Instructor and Chairman.

In the times when many people are addressed as great instructors, and others granted it to themselves teaching techniques different from their initial ones, Morio Higaonna is firm guarding the original message of the teachings of sensei Chojuna Miyagi. He does not permit changes in kata and technique.





What does he say about his trainings?

"I am pleased to say my training has hardly changed over the years. Recently I started to study meditation with Sakiyama sensei who is a famous Zen priest. Everyday I run, practice hojo undo, kata, and also meditation. My family is as supportive as ever so I am free to train for at least six hours each day.

"Of course you must remember that physical training is just the gateway to mastery of the mind. That's why you must strive to achieve true humility through training. Good karate makes good people, and I feel a responsibility to pass on what was given to me as a way of thanking my teacher, An'ichi Miyagi. (...) If you do not train hard you should not teach!"

What do other masters say about master Higaonna?

Don Draeger "is the most dangerous man in Japan in real fight". Terry 0'Neil – the famous European karate Shotokan champion (kata and kumite), said: "As close as one can come to the model of the classical karate master". Harry Cook, when asked about the greatest artist of martial arts, said: "Of the Japanese teachers I would have to say Morio Higaonna. Higaonna sensei can do it all; his basics are very powerful, his kata are excellent and he can demonstrate many bunkai for all the kata. There is no doubt about his fighting ability and he is exciting to watch. We used to watch him do demonstrations in Tokyo and you were always glad that you weren't his assistant! He's also very good at grappling; when he gets you in close you are in trouble.
